

Asbestos Activity Summary

We're pleased to inform you the building administration has continued to respond to the asbestos in buildings issue in a cautious and proactive manner. The Hershey Public School has a very small amount of asbestos in the building that is identified in our asbestos management plan. The asbestos is assumed in some pipe wrapping in the tunnels under the floor. The management plan is available for inspection in the Superintendent's office.

Building administration and custodial staff will continue with its ongoing asbestos operations and maintenance programs including periodic surveillance which are conducted on a quarterly basis. Identified below are the asbestos abatement activities that were completed over the past year or are planned for the upcoming year.

Response Actions Completed:

Periodic Surveillance

In addition, as required by AHERA (EPA), re-inspections are conducted by accredited inspectors every three years since the implementation of our management plan. The three year inspection was completed for the Hershey Public Schools by Inspect to Manage, Inc. from North Platte, NE on January 4, 2008.

Please rest assured the administration's ongoing efforts related to the management and control of asbestos-containing materials are focused on providing a safe and healthy environment for our building occupants and employees.
